- Misrepresentation of information will result in cancellation of a bursary, even if SANRAL becomes aware of it after the bursary has been awarded.
- Applicants with 'full cost bursaries' are discouraged from applying.
- The full academic record is required where the applicant is already at tertiary level (applicants applying in their second and third year, etc.).
- Applicants in matric are required to submit their term 1 and 2 results for 2022.
- If further information is required for verification processes, the applicant must be available to submit it.

MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS

Students at university need a 60% overall average.

Matriculants need a 70% overall average.

Accepted for studies that you applied for in the bursary application.

Proposed study aligned with the qualifications outlined in the application.

South African citizen.

Meet academic requirements.

Not older than 35 years.

Enrolment for full-time study.

The applicant's financial situation will be considered.

Study must be full-time at a recognised and approved public South African tertiary institution.

- Charges on the tuition account will be paid to the university directly, allowance payments will be made to the bursar's bank account. Payments will only be made for items that the bursary has been approved for.
- All payments made by parents/legal guardians will have to be substantiated with proof of payments and should be submitted to the bursary office for consideration of reimbursement.

Where a full bursary is awarded, bursars are not allowed to have any other funding that covers registration, tuition, accommodation, travelling allowance, food and books.

In the instance where a bursar has been awarded a partial bursary from another donor and the student has informed SANRAL thereof, SANRAL will pay only what is outstanding on tuition and allowances.

Awarding of the bursary is subject to positive verification of the applicant's credentials as provided in the application.

The bursary will continue from the date of the award, up until all requirements prescribed by the university/tertiary institution for the course undertaken are successfully completed.
